



Schedule 1 – Undergraduate and Non-Award Entry Requirements and Selection

Definitions

Term	Definition
Applicant	A person applying for admission to a program.
ATAR	The rank assigned to Australian school leavers by the relevant state authority which indicates a student's position relative to other students.
Associate Dean (Academic)	The relevant Associate Dean (Academic) of the faculty administering the award. For non-award students, the Associate Dean (Academic) of the faculty administering the course.
Bachelor's degree	The learning outcomes at level 7 under the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) with the volume of learning typically of 3–4 years duration.
Current year 12 applicant	A current year 12 student who has applied for admission to a UQ program. This is a student who is completing a first or second attempt in an approved senior secondary program in the year of application. For the purposes of entry to the Doctor of Medicine (provisional entry) and Bachelor of Medical Science/Doctor of Medicine programs, requirements for current Year 12 applicants are noted separately in the Admission to Coursework Procedure – Schedule 2 .
Full year of tertiary study	One equivalent full-time student load (EFTSL) of tertiary study at a bachelor's degree level or higher.
Non-award student	A student enrolled to study one or more courses without being admitted to a program which leads to an award of this University or to an award at another tertiary institution.
Place	Either a quota place or a fee-paying place in a program.
Program	A program published on the UQ Study website.
QTAC	Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre.
Quota	The number of offers to be made.
Quota place	Has the same meaning as 'Commonwealth supported place' in the <i>Higher Education Support Act 2003</i> (Cth).
Selection Rank	The admission score assigned to an applicant in accordance with the Admission to Coursework Procedure – Schedule 1 , Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 .
UQ	The University of Queensland.

Selection

- (1) The selection criteria to be used for each program are published on the [UQ Study](#) website. Unless stated otherwise, ATAR or selection rank will be used to select eligible applicants for offers.

Entry requirements

- (2) To be eligible for consideration for admission to a program an applicant must:
 - a. satisfy the subject prerequisite requirements



- b. meet any other requirements published on the [UQ Study](#) website
- (3) Subject prerequisite requirements may be met by one of the following:
 - a. obtaining a minimum result of C in Units 3 and 4 for each Queensland Curriculum & Assessment Authority (QCAA) prescribed subject; or
 - b. completing equivalent or alternative qualifications approved by the Associate Dean (Academic).
- (4) The University may refuse entry to any applicant who does not perform satisfactorily in a non-academic entry requirement such as an interview, test or written statement.

Selection Measures and Classification of Applicants

- (5) Current year 12 applicants will be considered for Semester 1 entry on the following basis, unless otherwise specified in the [Admission to Coursework Procedure – Schedule 2](#):
 - a. an applicant who has qualified for an ATAR in the year immediately preceding the year for which admission is sought will be considered for admission on the basis of their ATAR (and Casper score for the Bachelor of Veterinary Science (Honours))
 - b. an applicant who has completed an approved Australian senior secondary program in the year immediately preceding the year for which admission is sought but has not qualified for an ATAR will not be eligible for a selection rank
 - c. an applicant who has completed an approved non-Australian senior secondary program in the year immediately preceding the year for which admission is sought, will be considered for admission on the basis of a selection rank
 - d. despite paragraphs (a)–(c), a current year 12 applicant who has undertaken a full year of tertiary study at bachelor's degree level or higher will be assigned a selection rank under clause 7(b)
- (6) All other applicants will be considered for admission on the basis of a selection rank.

Hierarchy of Qualifications and Assigning Selection Ranks

- (7) Selection ranks are assigned by the University in a hierarchy according to the applicant's qualifications, as set out below unless otherwise specified in clause 5 (a-d):
 - a. If the applicant has previously undertaken two full years of tertiary study at bachelor's degree level or higher, their selection rank is calculated according to the [Admission to Coursework Procedure – Schedule 3](#).
 - b. If clause 7(a) does not apply, the selection rank assigned will be the highest calculated according to either of the following provided the applicant is not re-applying to a program in which they have failed to progress:
 - i. the [Admission to Coursework Procedure – Schedule 3](#)
 - ii. the relevant schedules prepared by QTAC and approved by the Academic Registrar.



- c. If clauses 7(a) and (b) do not apply and the applicant is a current year 12 applicant, a selection rank may only be calculated in accordance with the relevant senior secondary schedules prepared by QTAC and approved by the Academic Registrar or, for international applicants, the UQI Assessing Schedules approved by the Vice-Chancellor. Selection ranks will not be derived from other qualification types.
- d. If clauses 7(a), (b) and (c) do not apply the applicant's selection rank is calculated in accordance with relevant schedules prepared by QTAC and approved by the Academic Registrar or, if there are no relevant schedules, in a manner determined by the Associate Dean (Academic).

The selection rank or ATAR may be adjusted for selected programs where an applicant qualifies for an approved [Admission Scheme](#) under the [Admission to Coursework Procedure](#).

Order of offers

- (8) All applicants with a qualified ATAR or selection rank, in accordance with the criteria above, will be offered places in rank order until the quota is filled.
- (9) If it is necessary to choose between applicants, places are allocated in order on the basis of:
 - a. adjusted ATAR or selection rank, followed by unadjusted ATAR or selection rank
 - b. for the Bachelor of Dental Science (Honours), the Doctor of Medicine (MD) and Bachelor of Medical Science/Doctor of Medicine, the selection methodology outlined in the [Admission to Coursework Procedure – Schedule 2](#)
 - c. for the Bachelor of Veterinary Science (Honours) program, the Combined Final Selection Index as specified on the UQ Study website, followed by the adjusted ATAR or selection rank
 - d. in a manner determined by the Associate Dean (Academic), having considered any relevant academic data
