

## Degree Colours

The standard colours for hoods and facings for the degrees will correspond as nearly as possible with colours and numbers of the British Colour Council Dictionary of Colour Standards and the Australian Colour Standard AS2700S — shown in brackets below. Hoods and facings will be constructed of silk.

## Description of Academic Dress

Academic dress will be worn at special University ceremonies as Senate may from time to time determine.

### ACADEMIC DRESS FOR SENATE MEMBERS AND OFFICERS OF THE UNIVERSITY

Chancellor	Ordinary Chancellor's gown — or habit of degree — with a black silk stole embroidered with 7 blue Maltese Crosses encircled with gold braid.		Black velvet bonnet, with gold tassel.
Deputy Chancellor	Black silk gown with gold coloured cloth — with black silk stole embroidered with 5 blue Maltese Crosses encircled with gold cloth.		Black trencher, with gold tassel; or black velvet bonnet with gold tassel where their tertiary qualification is a doctorate.
Vice-Chancellor	Similar to Chancellor, but with silver braid and 5 blue Maltese Crosses encircled with silver braid.		Black velvet bonnet or trencher, with silver tassel.
Presiding Officer where not Chancellor or Deputy Chancellor	Black silk gown with gold coloured cloth — with black silk stole embroidered with 3 blue Maltese Crosses encircled with gold cloth.		Black trencher, with gold tassel; or black velvet bonnet with gold tassel where their tertiary qualification is a doctorate.
Member of Senate	A black silk or stuff gown with tippet of same material. The tippet to be edged with gold braid on a foundation of red silk ribbon and the sleeves caught up in front with gold braid on a similar foundation, about 15 cm in length, and gold buttons.	Of degree, if any.	Black trencher, with gold tassel; or bonnet of their prior tertiary qualification from this or another university, if any.
Ex-member of Senate	As for members of Senate.	Of degree, if any.	Black trencher, with gold tassel; or bonnet of their prior tertiary qualification from this or another university, if any.
Honorary Doctorate	Scarlet cloth or silk gown as for Cambridge ScD faced with silk of Gold (114).	Red silk or cloth fully lined with silk of Gold (114).	Velvet bonnet as worn by Cambridge doctors.
Official Visitor	Own academic or ceremonial dress	Of degree, if any.	Of academic or ceremonial dress.

## ACADEMIC DRESS FOR DEGREES, DIPLOMAS AND CERTIFICATES

Academic dress for graduation ceremonies will be the appropriate dress listed below for the award being presented at the ceremony. Academic dress worn outside of graduation ceremonies should be the academic dress for the highest qualification.

Graduate Certificate	Gown of the highest prior tertiary qualification from this or another university, if any; or a black gown, Cambridge Bachelor pattern.	Stole in Claret (R55).	Trencher or bonnet of the highest prior tertiary qualification from this or another university, if any; or a black cloth trencher with black tassel.
Graduate Diploma	Gown of the highest prior tertiary qualification from this or another university, if any; or a black gown, Cambridge Bachelor pattern.	Stole in Gold (114).	Trencher or bonnet of the highest prior tertiary qualification from this or another university, if any; or a black cloth trencher with black tassel.
Master' Degree, including extended Masters	Black gown, Cambridge Masters pattern	Black silk fully lined with silk of Empire Blue (87): Rich Blue (B11).	Black cloth trencher with black tassel.
Professional Doctorate	Black gown, Cambridge Masters pattern	Black silk fully lined with silk of Claret (R55).	Velvet bonnet as worn by Cambridge doctors.
Doctor of Philosophy	Black gown of the Cambridge Masters pattern, faced on each front panel with a 13 cm band of scarlet silk.	Black silk fully lined with silk of Union Jack Red (210): Crimson (R15).	Velvet bonnet as worn by Cambridge doctors.
Higher Doctorate	Scarlet cloth or silk gown as for Cambridge ScD faced with silk of Gold (114).	Red silk or cloth fully lined with silk of Gold (114).	Velvet bonnet as worn by Cambridge doctors.

### Optional Colours

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students are given the option of wearing stoles representing their respective community flags, over the academic gowns but underneath the hoods, at University graduation ceremonies.
