Notes for Part A and Part B

- 1. Results are generally valid for 5 years from the date of the qualification being granted to the commencement date at UQ. Citizens of designated countries listed in Part A of Table 2 are exempted from the 5-year validity period.
- 2. Countries marked with a '^' are exempted from the 5-year validity period.
- 3. It is assumed that the applicant will have completed the entire school qualification, where applicable, and the required results were achieved at year 12 (or equivalent).
- 4. Conditions for higher-than-minimum ELP programs apply only if <u>English Language Proficiency</u> <u>Admission—Table 1</u> explicitly permits such application. Specific application of clause 8(c) of <u>English</u> <u>Language Proficiency Admission Procedure</u> provided for a program in <u>English Language Proficiency</u> <u>Admission—Table 1</u> takes precedence over generic conditions for higher-than-minimum ELP programs provided in Other Recognised English Language Proficiency Tests or Qualifications Table above.
