

# Award of University Medals Policy

## Section 1 - Purpose and Objectives

(1) The Senate may award University Medals in recognition of outstanding academic merit in programs leading to an award of degrees specified in [Award of University Medals Procedure](#).

Term	Definition
CAPP	Committee for Academic Programs Policy
Degree	The level of award as defined in <a href="#">Awards - Table 1 - Awards Conferred by Senate</a> , including integrated programs that lead to the conferral of a single award.

## Section 3 - Policy Scope/Coverage

(2) This Policy applies to all students at The University of Queensland.

## Section 4 - Policy Statement

(3) Graduates who meet the eligibility criteria for the award of a University Medal, as specified in [Award of University Medals Procedure](#), may be nominated by the Executive Dean of the Faculty for the award of a University Medal. The nomination will be submitted to the Committee for Academic Programs Policy for approval and referral to the Academic Board for noting and to the Vice-Chancellor for sign-off.
