

Prohibited and Restricted Carcinogen – Form C

This form is not sent to Workplace Health and Safety Queensland (WHSQ) but must be completed and signed by the Principal Investigator and sent to the <u>HSW Division</u> after the authority from the Regulator is obtained, but advisable before submission.

The completion of this form should be overseen and signed by the work group supervisor. All fields must be completed in full.
