

# Multi-Faith Chaplaincy and Community Service Guideline

## Section 1 - Purpose and Scope

(1) This Guideline supports the [Multi-Faith Chaplaincy and Community Service Policy](#).

## Section 2 - Standing of Faith or Community Bodies

(2) The following will be considered when assessing the suitability of faith or community bodies for UQ standing:

- a. Any previous standing granted by UQ or other universities and associated activity;
- b. The broad position and reputation of the body in Australian Society;
- c. Recognition by the:
  - i. [Australian Taxation Office \(ATO\)](#)
  - ii. [Australian Business Register](#)
  - iii. [Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission](#);
- d. The likelihood of relevance of the faith or community body for the UQ Community; and
- e. Demonstration of the body's ability, capacity, and willingness to embrace and abide by the requirements of the [Multi-Faith Chaplaincy and Community Service Policy](#).

## Section 3 - Appointment of Chaplains

(3) The following will be considered when assessing applications to be a UQ Chaplain:

- a. The person must be nominated by a faith or community body that has current UQ standing;
- b. Any previous appointment of the person by UQ or other universities and associated activity;
- c. Demonstration of reputable character and good standing of the person;
- d. The likelihood that the person would contribute positively to the UQ Community; and
- e. Demonstration of the person's ability, capacity, and willingness to embrace and abide by the requirements of the [Multi-Faith Chaplaincy and Community Service Policy](#).
